21 March, the International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination, is observed annually on the day the police in Sharpeville, South Africa, opened fire and killed 69 people at a peaceful demonstration against apartheid "pass laws" in 1960.

There are now three internationally respected human rights organisations that have concluded that Israel is committing the crime of apartheid (Human Rights Watch, Amnesty International and B'tselem). The Israeli government, which has been working with far right governments and organisations around the world for years, today is an extremist government far to the right of the political spectrum.
