"I worked at Musselburgh Home Bargains for over a year. My biggest problem was the management. I was constantly given more shifts than I was supposed to work, whether I wanted them or not didn't matter. Shifts constantly got changed at the last minute without any notice. My colleague was told by management that if he went to HR they would make his life hell. Management were on a power trip and acted very inappropriately towards others. We would be scheduled to work until 9pm and then be expected to work again at 6am the next morning. Someone worked until 10pm and was also expected back at 6am. Morning shifts were stressful, I was told multiple times that I wasn't doing enough which wasn't helpful at all. Training was terrible, you were just thrown in to figure it out yourself."
